

The only substantive change in the constitution is to enlarge the geographical area of the club to include not only Swansea, but the surrounding area, as permitted by Art. V, Sec. 2(a) of the Constitution of Rotary International. The changes in the bylaws are designed to eliminate obsolete material relating to the first election of the club; to spell out the procedure for election of officers; and to otherwise conform to the standard bylaws of Rotary International.

Accordingly, pursuant to Article XVIII, Sec. 2 of the Constitution of the Rotary Club of Swansea and Article XIV of the Bylaws of the Rotary Club of Swansea, you are notified that the amended constitution and bylaws as hereto attached will be voted on at the general membership meeting to be held on Thursday, July 29, 7:30 a.m. at Schippa's Restaurant in Swansea, Illinois. Adoption of the amended constitution requires a majority vote of those present and voting; approval of the bylaws amendments requires a two-thirds vote of members present.
